

At 5:00 p.m. the Regular Meeting of the Alloway Township Finance Committee was called to order by P. Ed McKelvey, Mayor. The meeting was advertised in the designated newspapers in accordance with Public Law 1975, Chapter 231. The flag salute was led by Mayor McKelvey.

PUBLIC SESSION: Motion to open Public Session: Leady, seconded by: Angelus.

Vote: All in favor

Alloway Township Fire Chief, John Mahala gave updates regarding improvements made at the Fire House which included fresh paint. He thanked members that volunteered to complete the project. Chief Mahala stated that Engine 19-1 has failed pump testing multiple years in a row, it is not sifting properly and is currently out of service, and stated that it may not be financially beneficial to have it repaired. This truck is included in the ISO rating. He also gave updates on the Cascade Air truck, which is being repaired as it recently failed its air test.

FINANCE ITEMS:

The Township Committee members reviewed the Bill List and with no one having any questions, the approval sheet for the Bill List was signed.

OLD BUSINESS/UPDATES:

1. New port-o-pots have been installed at the lake and convenience center.
2. New Boat Ramp Fee box has been installed at the lake. Mayor McKelvey explained to the public that recently the money has been stole from the old box, so a new more secure one was constructed.
3. The Committee was given a packet of Public Works job descriptions to review.

CORRESPONDENCE:

1. Ranch Hope Live Nativity request was approved contingent on having a review of specifics with Ranch Hope, possibly making one way traffic through Saw Mill Road.
2. Statewide Insurance Renewal – Deputy Mayor Leady will review the list.
3. Acton Station Road Detour – The Committee agreed they would temporarily close Hart Lane to avoid potential damage from heavy truck traffic.
