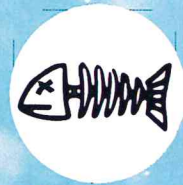
PLASTIC SMALLER THAN 5 MILLIMETERS

Plastic is very slow to disintegrate in our waterways. Over time sun, wind and wave action breaks down plastic waste into smaller and smaller pieces, known as microplastics.

80%

of marine plastic waste originates as land-based trash.

Microplastics are lethal to marine wildlife when ingested.
